President/CEO reviews it, it is submitted to the Board of Director's finance and accounting committees, each of which consists of two Board members. After being reviewed by the finance and accounting committees, the draft federal Form 990 is reviewed and approved by the full Board of Directors prior to being remitted to Raffa, P.C. to finalize and electronically file with the Internal Revenue Service.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 12c:

Explanation: The Board of Directors adopted an ethics and conflicts of interest policy. The Policy is provided to all leaders of SVA and must be filed annually. The Board of Directors monitors and enforces compliance violations. Individual trustees and officers are required to disclose any potential conflicts of interest as they pertain to the interests of SVA.

Form 990, Part VI, Section B, Line 15:

Explanation: Hiring and salary decisions are reviewed and approved independently by a designated Board member, under authority delegated by the Board of Directors. Salaries are based on a comparison of local costs of living, average rates of compensation, and in relation to the President/CEO's salary. Pay is adjusted for changes in location if they occur during employment. This is reflected in the contracts of officers. The process of setting employee salaries is incorporated into the employee search process. The President/CEO search process was conducted by a committee of the Board of Directors. All other employee search and hiring processes are conducted by the President/CEO and senior staff leadership. A delegated Board member approves all hiring decisions to provide independent review and approval from the Board of Directors.
